Native mobile sound-therapy application spanning real-time audio analysis, synthesis, and subscription commerce. iOS shipped to the App Store; Android in development.

- Built an instrument tuner supporting both 432 Hz and 440 Hz reference pitch, and a voice analyzer that measures vocal fundamental frequency and surfaces harmonic content in real time.
- Implemented a tanpura-style drone generator that tunes itself to the user's vocal fundamental, plus a harmonics module covering the circle of fifths, pentatonic scales, and interval matching.
- Developed a tap-tempo rhythm trainer with note-division control, and tempo-guided breathwork sequences built on the same timing engine.
- Shipped monthly, annual, and lifetime in-app subscription tiers gating the full toolkit.
